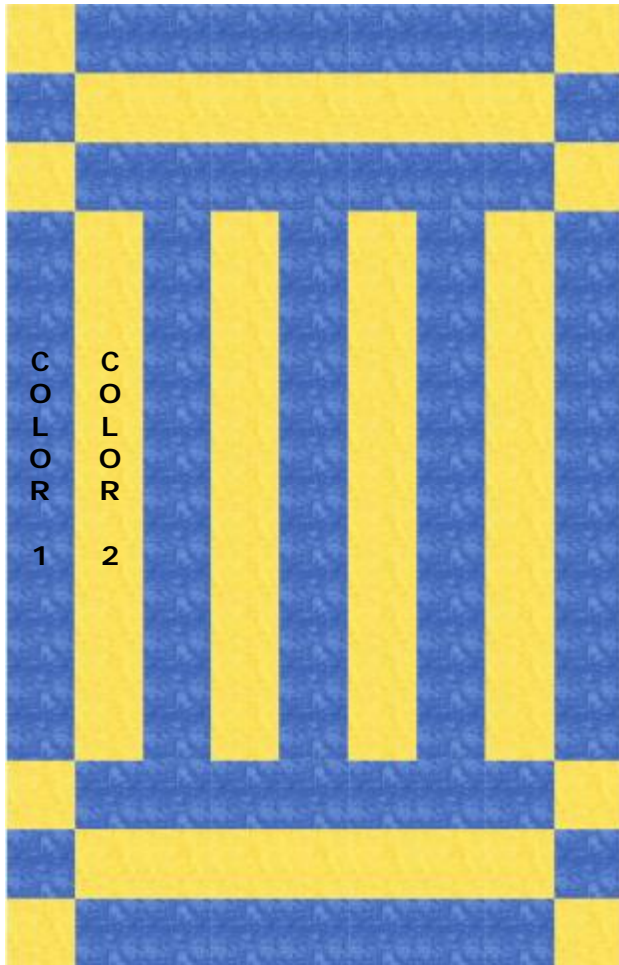


Easy Strip Quilt

- 1 border at each end - finished size: 45" x 50"
- 2 borders at each end - finished size: 45" x 60"
- 3 borders at each end - finished size: 45" x 70"



Cut all strips 5½" wide.

For Center Section of Quilt:

Color 1

- Cut 5 strips - 5 1/2" x 40 1/2"

Color 2

- Cut 4 strips - 5 1/2" x 40 1/2"

For Borders:

Cutting directions are for 3 borders at each end.

Color 1

- Cut 4 - 5 1/2" strips
- From each strip - Cut one (1) 35 1/2" strip and one (1) 5 1/2" block

Color 2

Cut 3 - 5 1/2" strips

- From two strips - Cut one (1) 35 1/2" piece & one (1) 5 1/2" piece.
- From remaining strip - Cut six (6) - 5 1/2" strips

To make borders all one color - You won't have to piece the borders if you cut the strips length wise (parallel to the salvage): 45 1/2" long by whatever width you want.

If you are using directional fabric - be sure to cut the strips to correspond with the direction of the fabric print.

Suggestion: Make a scrappy Easy Strip Quilt.
Every strip can be a different color or print.

Remember: All strips are cut 5½" wide

For each quilt you will need 7 - 40½" for the up/down stripes.

One border quilts will need 2 - 35 ½" strips & 4 - 5½" squares

Two border quilts will need 4 - 35½" strips & 8 - 5½" squares

Three border quilts will need 6 - 35½" strips & 12 - 5½" squares
